

Ecuador

A report on the birds seen during a trip to northern Ecuador
from 21 July till 15 August 2005 by David Van den Schoor



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INTRODUCTION

This trip covers a 25 days trip to northern Ecuador. During my last 11 days I was accompanied by a Belgian friend David Herman. My main aim was to see as many as possible Andean specialities only occurring in the northern part of the country, as many as possible Antpittas and a good variety of Amazonian species. Next time, I will visit southern Ecuador, hoping to see Jocotoco Antpitta..... I'm not going to write a true 'trip report', as good descriptions have been made in several reports (see references). I managed to see (or hear) 681 species, following strictly taxonomy, names and sequence of James F. Clements 5th edition. An additional 7 species were seen too if following the taxonomy using by Robert S. Ridgely & Paul Greensfield (Field Guide – The Birds of Ecuador).

GEOGRAPHY

Ecuador is located on the North-Western coast of South America, between Peru to the South and East and Colombia to the north. Ecuador also owns the famous Galapagos Islands, located approximately 1000 kilometres off the coast. Ecuador covers 256370 square kilometres of land and is the smallest country in South America after Uruguay and the Guiana's. Despite Ecuador's diminutive size - about equal to the North American state of Colorado - it is one of the most geographically diverse countries in the world. Ecuador is comprised of four distinct geographical regions: El Oriente (Amazon jungle) in the east, La Sierra (Andes mountains) in the centre, La Costa (the Pacific coastal lowlands) in the west, and the majestic Galapagos Islands off the coast.

FLIGHT AND VISA

I flew from Brussels to Quito via Madrid with Iberia Airlines for 1190,00 EUR return, taxes included. Very expensive! For the 25 minutes during domestic flight Quito – Coca, I had to pay US\$ 120 return, taxes included. This flights are operated by ICARO.

US\$ 25 departure tax is charged upon leaving Ecuador via an international flight.

Tourists from most countries may get monthly extensions up to 180 days. Tourist visas are extended on the last valid day. Immigration officials will stamp either 60 or 90 days in your passport when you enter. If you know you need more than 60 days, be sure to tell them before they stamp your passport. Also, if you want to stay longer than 90 days you will have to get an extension or obtain a visa. To learn more about visas, check with your local Ecuadorian consulate or your embassy in Ecuador for details pertaining to your citizenship. In Quito they are obtained at the immigration office on Isla Seymour 1152, between Rio Coca and Tomás de Berlanga. In Guayaquil go to the immigration office on Avenida Pichincha and Aguirre. Ecuador requires a valid passport from all travellers, as well as proof of return to your home country or onward journey, though this is rarely checked. At this time no yellow fever vaccination is required.

MONEY

In March 2000, Ecuador's official currency changed from the Sucre to the U.S. Dollar. All bills are true US currency. There are some coins that the Ecuadorian Government has minted themselves that are not US coins. One dollar coins, which are actually US coins but are not generally known in the US are quite common. It is wise to check bills you receive, especially larger denomination ones to assure they are not counter fit before accepting them from anyone (banks included). Credit cards and travellers cheques are generally accepted in the cities. You should ensure you bring enough money, in the form of US dollars or travellers' cheques.

CAR RENTAL

I arranged a A-class car (Chevrolet Corsa 5-doors) by AVIS at Mariscal Sucre International Airport (Quito) and paid US\$ 715,20 for 19 days including all taxes, assurances (Collision Damage Waiver) and unlimited mileage. Good to now is that all car-rental companies are just outside the airport. It is advisable to book in advance like I did via www.cheapairlines.com . Drivers must be fully licensed and 21 or older. Cars drive on the right. Petrol fluctuated around US\$ 0,50 per litre.

Most of the roads I travelled on were in very good condition, the unpaved road in the Tandayapa Valley is also good passable. Only the road between Hollín (at the main junction to Quito and Coca around KM 24) and Tena is in very bad condition!

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Travellers need to be particularly cautious with respect to what they eat and drink and to insect bites. Hepatitis A and Typhoid Fever are the two most common diseases transmitted through food and water. Yellow Fever and Malaria are the most common diseases transmitted by insects.

www.1cover.co.uk/countries.html health section provides an overview of these and other medical

considerations for those travelling in Ecuador. Health is always an issue of concern for people travelling abroad. Most travellers stay healthy throughout their journeys and return home as fit as ever. You have little to worry about if you educate yourself and take sensible precautions.

Ecuador is considered one of the safer countries in the Andean Region, though its recent economic woes have caused crime to increase significantly. Ecuador's urban centres, especially Quito and Guayaquil are large cities and like most any large city in the world, are generally more dangerous than the countryside.

FOOD AND DRINK

Ecuador is known for its fabulous exotic fruits, high quality fish and seafood, and the countless varieties of Andean potatoes. Across the country you'll find a broad spectrum of national and regional dishes, including lemon-marinated shrimp, toasted corn, and pastries stuffed with spiced meats. If you're feeling courageous, you can put your culinary bravery to the test with roasted cuy (guinea pig) or tronquito (bull penis soup).

For those on a budget, the best way to stretch your money is to take advantage of set plate meals, an Ecuadorian institution in many restaurants. Lunches (almuerzos) and dinners (meriendas) usually give you a soup, main course (including meat), and dessert for around US\$ 2,00. Vegetarian versions are often available upon request.

At only pennies per bite, bakeries offer a delicious range of breads, sweet pastries, and savory snacks, such as empanadas (hot, crispy meat or cheese-filled pastries) and llapingachos (potato and cheese pancakes). Dishes sold in the street are also quite cheap, but hygiene is often questionable, and you may quickly surpass your intestinal limits. A good rule to follow is the "locals rule" -- if the place is frequented by many locals, the food probably merits joining the crowd.

For the sake of your intestinal happiness, drink only bottled or boiled water, not water from the tap. Distilled and sparkling waters from Ecuadorian springs are available throughout the country and are of good quality. Remember that tap water is frequently used in ice, so request your beverages "sin hielo" (without ice) in restaurants.

LANGUAGE

Ecuador is a country where English is not spoken widely (except in some Lodges), so at least a rudimentary command of Spanish will be helpful. Some of the younger generation in the bigger cities speak a little English and genuinely tried to help when we had language difficulties.

WEATHER

On account of Ecuador's varied regions and because of its location directly atop the equator, it is an excellent travel destination year-round. Rather than rotating through four seasons, most of Ecuador experiences oscillating wet and dry periods. The general weather trends for each region are as follows:

El Oriente (Amazon region) normally has a warm, humid and rainy climate. The average temperature varies from 23° to 26° C (72 to 80 F). The drier season is generally November to February but varies by region.

La Sierra (Andean Highlands), though on the equator, is generally cooler than most people would expect. The climate in the Andes varies according to the altitude and the time of the year. In Quito the temperature ranges from 7° C (55 F) at night, to 26° C (78 F) at noon, averaging 15° C (64 F).

La Costa's (Coastal lowlands) climate is usually very warm with temperatures averaging 25° C (76 F) to 31° C (90 F) during the year. The rainy season (December to May) is warm and very humid. The dry season is less humid but still a little muggy.

The Galapagos islands enjoy warm and dry weather year-round, with an average temperature of 28° C. (85 F).

TIME ZONE

CET Time minus 6 hours during our winter time and minus 7 hours during our summer time.

The Galapagos are one hour earlier than the mainland.

ELECTRICITY

Electric appliances operate on an alternating current, the same as the United States - 110 volts, 60 cycles (Hertz) AC. So, American-styled two-pin plugs are most common. This means that European travellers need to bring an adapter for laptops, cameras, hair dryers, etc.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation in Ecuador is numerous at most visited sites and rather cheap. Listed below are all visited hotels (and their prices, incl. taxes per night) I stayed in during the trip.

Take note that access to the trails is not allowed at Tandayapa if not staying in the lodge!

PERMITS AND ACCESS

No permits were needed at any of the places that I have visited. Only a entrance fee of US\$ 5 is charged to visit Bellavista Lodge (if not staying), the Yellow-house trail at Mindo (2 days valid), Tony & Barbara's Hummingbird feeders, Yanacocha, Milpe or the Four Rivers (Finca KM 106.5). For visiting (if not staying) Tinalandia, Guango Lodge or Cabañas San Isidro, you have to pay US\$ 10.

ITINERARY

Thursday 21 July:

Iberia Airlines IB3207 Brussels – Madrid (08:10-10:30) and Iberia Airlines IB6635 Madrid - Quito (12:10-16:15). After collecting the luggage, met my friends Tom and Suzanne in the airport and drove straight to San Antonio de Achincha for an overnight at Hotel Rancho Alegre.

Friday 22 July:

Early start at 5:45 to Calacali where we saw 5 White-tailed Shrike-Tyrants within 2 hours! Returned around 8:00 to the hotel and drove after a quick breakfast to the private hangar of ICARO (near the domestic Airport). After saying goodbye, I took the 25 minutes flight 506 (11:00) Quito – Puerto Francisco de Orellana, locally known as Coca. A member of the Sacha Lodge was picking me and a few other visitors up there and took us to a private dock. Here we had pause for a snack before boarding our covered motorized canoe for a 2 and a half hour, c50 mile (80 kilometres) trip down the Rio Napo. Birding for the rest of the afternoon (15:00) along the boardwalk and around the Sacha Lodge with Oscar Tapuy, my birding guide during my 6 days stay here. Owling till 21:00.

Saturday 23 July:

Sacha Lodge: We spent the whole morning on the 275 meters long canopy-walk and the rest of the day birding on the trails around the Lodge. After dinner, again out for night-birds.

Sunday 24 July:

Sacha Lodge: start early to visit one of the unnamed Rio Napo islands and spend the rest of the day on the southern banks of the river at Yasuní National Park. Owling till 21:30.

Monday 25 July:

Sacha Lodge: first visiting the wooden canopy tower (because overcast less productive than the canopy-walk), spent the rest of the day again on the trails around the Lodge and end the day with a second visit to the canopy-walk. We were hanging around there till 19:00 but were unlucky with Long-tailed Potoo.

Tuesday 26 July:

Sacha Lodge: Unfortunately, almost a full day heavy rain! We were starting very early to the same unnamed Rio Napo island but had to seek shelter quite early after arriving. Even more, we had to cancel a new visit to the Yasuní National Park because of the bad weather. Raindrops were only stopping for a few hours around noon and we were visiting another unnamed island on that time, more than one hour down the Rio Napo.

Wednesday 27 July:

Sacha Lodge: birding til 8:00 along the boardwalk and afterwards navigating back to Coca.
Flight 507 (11:00) Coca – Quito. After picking up my car by AVIS, drive to Bellavista where I arrived around 16:00. Birding for the rest of the afternoon around the Research Station.
Night at Bellavista Research Station.

Thursday 28 July:

Bellavista Lodge: full day birding on the trails W, F and H plus along the dirty road to the Research Centre. Out for Owling around the Lodge and around the pass. Night at Bellavista Research Station.

Friday 29 July:

Bellavista Lodge: birding on the same places then previous day plus visiting Tony & Barbara's Hummingbird Feeders (15:00 till 16:00). Night at Bellavista Research Station.

Saturday 30 July:

A.m. birding at Bellavista Lodge and p.m. birding at Tandayapa Lodge (Potoo and Antpitta trail).
Night at Tandayapa Lodge.

Sunday 31 July:

Tandayapa Lodge: full day birding on the trails near the Lodge and late afternoon at the beginning of the old Nono Road. I stayed till 18:30 for Lyre-tailed Nightjar but again fruitless!
Night at Mindo in Hotel El Bijao.

Monday 1 August:

Mindo area: a.m. birding along the Yellow-house trail and p.m. birding around the Rio Nambillo area.
Night at Mindo.

Tuesday 2 August:

Mindo area: a.m. birding at Mindo Loma where I met Patricio Herrera, a 21 young local birding guide who lives here. P.m. with Patricio to Milpe. Night at Mindo.

Wednesday 3 August:

Again Patricio was accompanied me, we left very early for Yanacocha where we stayed till 11:00. Returned via Quito and drove straight to the Four Rivers (Finca KM 106.5) where we spent the rest of the day. Night at Mindo where my friend David Herman finally arrived around dinner time. 2 days later than actual planned but that's another story.....

Thursday 4 August:

A.m. birding at Pedro Vicente Maldonado (KM126). Say goodbye to Patricio and leaving for Tinalandia where we had almost the full afternoon for birding around the Golf Course. Night at Santa Domino de los Colorados in Hotel Tropical Inn.

Friday 5 August:

A.m. birding at Tinalandia and p.m. birding at Rio Palenque Scientific Station. Night at Rio Palenque in the Science Hotel.

Saturday 6 August:

Full day birding at Rio Palenque Scientific Station.
Night at Rio Palenque.

Sunday 7 August:

Birding at Rio Palenque Scientific Station till 11:00 and drove than straight to the eastern slope where we arrived at 16:30. Spent the rest of the afternoon around the pass and the road to the antennas.
Night at Papallacta in Hotel Templas.

Monday 8 August:

Again a day with fog and almost constantly rain till half afternoon! So, we visited a lot of places for rather a short time today. We started bird watching near Papallacta Village, drove then to Papallacta Lake (a few km. from the village in the direction of the pass) and continue to the East side from the pass where there is a patch of *polylepis* forest. We visited the paramo lake behind this forest patch too. It was still raining and we returned to Papallacta Village and drove another 10 km. for Guango Lodge where we spent a few hours at the feeders. It was a good decision because we saw no less than 15 species of Hummers, including Mountain Avocetbill. On that time the weather brighten up and we drove straight to the pass for the last few hours and where very lucky to flushed 2 Rufous-bellied Seedsnipes from the road (just before the antennas). All by all, we had a quite good day!
Night at Papallacta.

Tuesday 9 August:

A.m. birding at Papallacta (the pass, the *polylepis* forest plus the paramo lake and finally Papallacta Lake). Start around noon for Cabañas San Isidro where we visited the feeders and the Log trail that afternoon. Night at Baeza in Hotel Bambus.

Wednesday 10 August:

Start on the Inca trail at Cordillera de Huacamayos but had to change our planning again because of the heavy rain and fog there. Drove down again to Cabañas San Isidro where we spent some time along the Antvireo trail and the Cock-of-the-rock trail between the showers. Night at Baeza.

Thursday 11 August:

Today the weather was excellent. So, we started again on the Inca trail at Cordillera de Huacamayos and stayed here till 16:00. Then we leaved for Loreto Road because the fog was quickly coming up. When arriving, there left 1 hour or so for roadside birding. Night at Tena in the Indiyana Hostel.

Friday 12 August:

Birding at Loreto road. We found it far from straightforward to find out where to bird but we tried to find the trail at the forested area on your right hand side towards Coca, 2,6 kilometres from the main junction Quito – Tena. We found the beginning of the trail without any trouble but after already a few hundred meters we came at a clearing where locals were cut down lots of trees on that moment and it was impossible to continue the trail! For a moment, I was thinking to be at PICOP, a quickly disappeared lowland rainforest that I have visited last winter in the Philippines! So, the only remaining option was roadside birding between KM 3 and KM 18 but it was quite hot today and almost no bird activity. Certainly my most disappointed birding day this trip! When arriving late afternoon at Cabañas San Isidro, we spent from 17:00 on again birding along the Log trail. Night at Cabañas San Isidro.

Saturday 13 August:

Birding at Cabañas San Isidro till noon (Cock-of-the-rock trail and Antvireo trail). After lunch again to the Inca trail at Cordillera de Huacamayos but stayed here only a few hours, indeed, again because of the fog was quickly coming up. Returned to Cabañas San Isidro where I spent the rest of the afternoon around our cabins, overlooking the valley with my telescope. Today, my friend must be returning to Tena where he has left some objects of value in our previous hotel. Night at Cabañas San Isidro.

Sunday 14 August:

A.m. birding at Cabañas San Isidro (Cock-of-the-rock trail).
Returning after lunch (12:30) to Quito International Airport for connecting my flight IB6634 with Iberia Airlines Quito - Madrid (17:40-13:45).

Monday 15 August:

Iberia Airlines IB3214 Madrid - Brussels (16:20-18:35).

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SYSTEMATIC LIST OF BIRDS

Taxonomy strictly follows names and sequence of James F. Clements (Birds of the World, A Checklist, Fifth Edition 2000) with a few exceptions of recent taxonomic decisions and names changes (see also www.ibispub.com/updates.html), updated till 15 July 2005. Some interesting subspecies (or potential taxonomic splits) are also mentioned. Notes of threatened species on the IUCN Red List were taken of "Threatened Birds of the World" – BirdLife International (2000), see also <http://www.birdlife.org/datazone/species/index.html> . For some species no details are given about their abundance, this automatically indicates that the species was seen regularly, it does however not necessarily mean that it is common. The list only contains species *positively* identified by at least one of our group. Birds identified by guides or other people only are *not* included, presumed species neither...

Snowy Egret *Egretta thula*

Rio Palenque Scientific Station - 6 August 2005 – 8 birds at the river near the Lodge.

Cattle Egret *Bubulcus ibis*

Mindo (Yellow-house trail) - 1 August 2005 - c25

Mindo Loma - 2 August 2005 - c10

Milpe - 2 August 2005 - c20

Zigzag Heron *Zebrilus undulatus*

Sacha Lodge (Yasuní NP) - 24 July 2005 - a single heard along the boardwalk.

Sacha Lodge - 26 July 2005 – the same bird, only heard.

Sacha Lodge - 27 July 2005 – 2 birds along the boardwalk. Unfortunately, one bird taped in at dawn till less than 5 metres but didn't come out the dense vegetation.

Green Ibis *Mesembrinibis cayennensis*

Sacha Lodge (Yasuní NP) - 24 July 2005 - only heard along the boardwalk.

Speckled Teal *Anas flavirostris*

Papallacta Pass - 8 August 2005 - c30 birds at Papallacta Lake.

Note : Robert S. Ridgely & Paul Greensfield (Field Guide – The Birds of Ecuador) split off this form as a separate species, using the name Andean Teal *Anas andium*.
